### **2. ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATION:**

A candidate must possess the qualification/Eligibility criteria and degree as mentioned against the subject, for which he/she is applying by **19.03.2026**. The candidates who are completing their requisite qualification/Eligibility criteria after **19.03.2026** are not eligible to take up this examination.

#### **A. General Eligibility Criteria For Admission Of External Candidates:**

##### **i. Candidates holding Medical Qualification:**

Must possess a Medical degree or a Postgraduate degree in the subject concerned or equivalent qualification included in any one of the Schedules to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956) and National Medical Commission Act, 2019 or recognized by the respective regulatory bodies, and candidates who have obtained MBBS/BDS/DNB/MD/MS/MDS degree are eligible to apply.

- ii. **Candidates holding Non- Medical Qualification:** The qualification for Non-Medical candidates has mentioned in eligibility criteria of **table 2(B)**.
- iii. **Minimum aggregate marks to be obtained in the Qualifying Degree Examination:** Candidates who have obtained their qualifying degree scoring at least 55% marks in aggregate shall be eligible to apply for the PhD entrance examination.
- iv. **Criteria for candidates already holding a PhD Degree:** Candidates who already possess a PhD Degree awarded/successfully qualified in any subject by AIIMS, Raipur/any other recognized academic institution, shall not be eligible to apply for another additional PhD degree at AIIMS, Raipur.

**6. METHOD OF SELECTION:** Selection for Ph.D. Registration will be through a three-stage performance evaluation through a common entrance test in Medical, Nursing and Allied Health Sciences.

**c. Performance Evaluation:** Selection for Ph.D. registration will be through a three-stage performance evaluation as under:

**i. Stage I: 40 Marks** (40 MCQs of 1 Mark each): Aptitude related MCQs covering English (Written and verbal skills), Biostatistics, Research Methodology, etc.

**Stage II: 40 Marks** (40 MCQs of 1 Mark each): Subject related theory based Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) mainly exploring broad based basic scientific knowledge and particularly analytical aptitude for research in the subject.

**Total Marks (Stage I + II) : 80 (40+40) marks**

**Total Duration (Stage I + II) : 90 Minutes**

ii. **Evaluation Procedure For Stage I And Stage II:**

Each correct (MCQ) answer will be awarded 1 mark. There will be no negative marking. More than one answer, overwriting, correction, questions not answered or marked for review will be treated as wrong answer.

**Candidates must score at least 50% in aggregate in stages I and II (combined) to be eligible for stage-III.**

**Stage-III (10 Marks):** After qualifying the Stage I and Stage II, the candidate will be called for Interview which will be taken by panel consisting of: **Head of the respective department & two faculties who have submitted undertaking for willingness to guide PhD candidate.**

➤ **The Special Weightage (10 Marks) to:**

A) **Medical/Dental/Nursing Candidates:**

Ten marks (10) will be added to the total stages I & II for candidates who fulfill the following criteria: If they hold a medical degree (MBBS/BDS/MDS/DNB/MD/MS/DM/M.Ch.) Or M.Sc Nursing.

B) **Non-Medical Candidates:**

Ten marks (10) will be added to the total stages I & II for candidates who fulfill the following criteria: Qualified in any one of the following in the last 2 years.

Joint CSIR-UGC NET for JRF

ICMR-JRF

DBT-JRF

NBHM Screening test

Employee in extramural research project under faculty who is PI in the same department of candidate.

**[The documents of proof of funding agency should be uploaded during submission of application.]**

- Note:**
- I) Final result will be declared on the basis of marks scored in stage I, II & III and special weightage. The result will be available on website of the institute.
  - II) Candidates who fail to attend any of the stages of examinations as mentioned above will not be eligible for admission.
  - III) Admission to Ph.D. Course will be subject to the availability of research funds/fellowship/grant/stipend from AIIMS, Raipur/recognized funding agencies.
  - IV) From the list of qualified candidates, 03 times as many candidates as the number of seats advertised for each department shall be put up for waiting list.

### **iii. DOCUMENT VERIFICATION:**

All the selected candidates will be called for verification of documents. Only those candidates who fulfil all the eligibility condition will be offered admission to PhD course.

Waitlisted candidates will be offered admission only if any selected candidate is found not qualified or fails to join within stipulated paid.

## **8. JOINING:**

Selected candidates will be intimated through e-mail. The selected candidates are required to join as per the date given in his/her provisional offer letter. In case the candidate fails to join within stipulated time, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the basis of waiting list, unless a written request for up to 15 days extension is received by the competent authority who may permit an extension of joining for this additional 15 days based on merit of each case. In case the candidate fails to join by this date, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course, and these will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.

The seat will ordinarily lapse for the respective session if any candidate fails to join by intimated date, as the case may be. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

## **9. INTER-SE-MERIT:**

### **For Medical Candidates:**

If two or more candidates obtained equal marks in the entrance examination, their inter-se-merit for selection shall be determined on the basis of the following:

- a) Candidate who has made more attempts in passing the various professional MD/MS/DNB/MDS/MBBS examination shall rank junior to the candidate who has made lesser attempts.
- b) If the attempts made in passing MD/MS/DNB/MDS/MBBS professional examinations are also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks in the MBBS examination shall rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lower marks. In case any candidate has not filled up relevant column no.14 of application form showing the percentage of aggregate marks in MBBS, he/she will rank junior to the candidate in inter-se-merit.
- c) If the attempts made in passing MD/MS/DNB/MDS/MBBS professional examination as also the marks obtained in MBBS examination are the same, then a candidate senior in age shall rank senior to a candidate who is junior in age.

A "Failure" in the examination, or "Re-appear" in the examination will constitute an attempt.

### **For Non-Medical Candidates:**

If two or more candidates obtain equal marks in the entrance examination for admission to Ph. D. then their inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:

- a) Candidate who has made more attempts in passing Post-graduate examination would rank junior to the candidate who has made lesser attempts.
- b) If attempts made in passing of Post-graduate examination are also the same, then candidate who has obtained higher marks in the Post-graduate examination will rank higher to a candidate who obtained lesser marks.
- c) If attempts made in passing Post-graduate examination and the marks obtained in Post-graduate examination are also the same, then the candidate senior in age shall rank higher to the candidate junior in age.

## 10. MEDICAL EXAMINATION:

Medical fitness will be a pre-condition for registration of all candidates. The candidates will be medically examined by a Medical Board, constituted by the Institute for this purpose to determine their medical fitness.

## 11. COURSE FEE & STIPEND FOR EXTERNAL CANDIDATES:

<b>Course Fee</b>	₹ 5225/- for entire course
<b>Stipend *</b>	₹ 31000/- per month for first three years and then ₹ 15000/- per month for next two years. No stipend will be given beyond 5 years.

**Note 1:** The Hostel Security deposit (refundable) i.e. Rs. 1000/- if offered accommodation.

**Note 2:** Fees and other charges including hostel rent once paid shall not be refunded in any case and no correspondence will be entertained in this connection. However, the caution money will be refunded to those candidates who do not join the course. The caution money must be claimed within one year after completion of the course failing which it will be forfeited.

## 12. GENERAL INFORMATION:

## 13. HOW TO APPLY:

- (A) **Candidate can apply online for Ph.D. course through Google Form <https://forms.gle/YuSDDvmoPo2xTneH6>.**
- (B) Candidates working under Central Govt./Semi Govt./Autonomous organization should submit their applications through proper channel i.e. employer. They will be required to submit a 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer before they are allowed to join the Ph.D. Course.
- (C) Applicants must fill all the fields **carefully** since after submission of online application request for change in any information at any later stage will **NOT** be considered.
- (D) The candidates are requested to fill the correct details regarding name/age/sex/caste/address/educational qualification and other relevant fields mentioned in the application.
- (E) Once the details are correctly filled the candidate may proceed for the fee payment.
- (F) **Once form is submitted there shall be no provision for making changes in the application form**

## 14. APPLICATION FEE AND MODE OF PAYMENT:

### Mode of Payment: Through Online

- General / OBC Category: Rs.1500/- + Transaction Charges as applicable
  - SC/ST Category: Rs.1200/- + Transaction Charges as applicable
  - PWBD Candidates is exempted from application fee
- (A) **Payment of fee:** Candidates can pay the application fee through **ONLINE**. Visit AIIMS Raipur official website: [www.aiimsraipur.edu.in](http://www.aiimsraipur.edu.in) and go to the **E-PAY (present in the top of the AIIMS Raipur Website)** option and select the **student** option and fill the complete details for payment. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate. **Candidates are advised to take a print of the receipt of fee of application form for their records and future reference.**
  - (B) Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as **INCOMPLETE**.

- (C) Payment of application fees by any other mode viz Cash, Cheque, Money Orders, Postal Orders, Pay Orders, Banker's Cheques, Postal Stamps, etc., will not be accepted. Such applications will be summarily rejected. The decision of Executive Director, AIIMS Raipur in this regard shall be final and binding.
- (D) Application fee is required to be remitted **online** only. Any other instrument of payment is not acceptable. Please make sure that the confirmation of the successful remittance by your bank and retain the proof of the same which may be required at the time of document verification. The application fee is non-refundable.

## 15. GUIDELINES REGARDING PHOTOGRAPHS, SIGNATURES and FORM:

### A. Guidelines for scanning the photograph & Signature:

Before applying online, a candidate will be required to have a scanned (JPG, JPEG) image of his/her photograph and signature as per the specifications given below:

#### (i) **Photograph:**

- Photograph must be recent passport size coloured, preferably white, background.
- Caps, hats and dark glasses are not allowed. Religious headwear is allowed but it must not cover the face.
- Dimensions 200 x 230 pixels (preferred)
- Size of JPG file should be between 80 kb–100 kb essentially
- Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 100 KB.
- **File name of photograph is: Photo\_Applicant Name\_PhD subject**

#### (ii) **Signature:**

- The applicant has to sign on white paper with Black ink pen by the applicant.
- The signature will be used to put on the Hall Ticket and wherever necessary.
- If the Applicant's signature on the answer script, at the time of the examination, does not match the signature on the Hall Ticket, the applicant will be disqualified.
- Dimensions 140 x 60 pixels (preferred)
- Size of file should be between 50 kb – 80 kb essentially
- Ensure that the size of the scanned image is not more than 80 KB.

## 16. CASTE CERTIFICATE:

1. For the purpose of application fee, the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PWBD category, the candidate must possess a certificate issued by competent authority (as applicable to category/format provided by AIIMS Raipur).
2. OBC (NCL) certificate must be issued within one year of last date for **application 19.03.2026 (i.e. issued between 18.02.2025 to 19.03.2026)**.
3. EWS certificate should be issued on or after on 01.04.2025 to last date of filling of application form i.e. 19.03.2026 based on the income of year 2024-2025.

## 17. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI):

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) registered under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 are eligible to appear in Ph.D. courses and all terms and conditions for Indian Nationals will be applicable to the candidates. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 to be eligible to appear for this test. This is in addition to conditions laid down in PhD Guidelines 2025 of AIIMS, Raipur.

## 18. SUBMISSION OF CASTE CERTIFICATE BY SC/ST/OBC CANDIDATES:

After declaration of result of the Entrance Examination, candidates belong to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe and Other Backward Classes should submit, along with other requisite documents, an attested copy of a certificate from any one of the following **authorities stating that the candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Classes in the prescribed form.**

- A. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1<sup>st</sup> Class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- B. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- C. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- D. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally resides.
- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorised in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.07.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.

**Candidates must note that a certificate from any other person/authority will not be accepted and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. The name, designation and the seal of the officer should be legible in the certificate.**

## 19. REASONS FOR REJECTION/CANCELLATION OF APPLICATION:

APPLICATIONS/CANDIDATURE OF APPLICANTS ARE LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED/REJECTED SUMMARILY OR AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF ALL OR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- i. Applications being incomplete.
- ii. Any variation in the Signatures.  
All the SIGNATUREs in FULL (NOT IN SHORT) done on the Print out of the Application Form and also on other Documents must be the same.
- iii. Scanned copy of photograph and signature uploaded are not as per specification given and/or blur or distorted or not clear.
- iv. Non-payment of Application Fees or non-receipt of fee through online mode, if not otherwise exempted.
- v. Fee not paid as per instructions.
- vi. Failure to bring (**in original**) all relevant Certificates/Documents issued by the competent authority, along with self-attested legible copies in support of the information given in their Application Forms about their Educational Qualifications; Experiences; Percentage of Marks obtained; Proof of Age; Proof of Category [SC/ST/OBC] and the print out of Application Form at the time of verification of document.
- vii. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Experience/Category Status as on the closing date.
- viii. Incorrect information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.

- ix. For carrying mobile phones / accessories in the Examination premises/Hall.
- x. Any other irregularity

## 20. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

- (A) Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document.
